Sparkling Wine / Champagne



- 1 **Prosecco Di Maria Spumante Non Vintage (Veneto)** 20cl **£6.50**

ITALY 11% [2]

This is a smooth, fresh and fruity Italian fizz with attractive aromas of wisteria flowers and russet apples. On the palate there's a hint of sweet almond, typical of the Prosecco grape variety.

- 2 **Bosco Dei Cirmioli Prosecco Spumante** **£25.00**

ITALY 11% [3]

A lively, crisp Italian sparkling wine which is aromatic and fresh with light lemon, pear and apple flavours and a floral hint. It has a dry, wonderfully refreshing finish.

- 3 **Marques de la Sardana Cava (Penedes)** **£24.50**

FRANCE 12.5% [1]

"If you want to hear the pop of a cork without having to pay champagne prices, this cava is made in the same way as its French cousin. Round and smooth, it's great fun and a wonderful choice for sharing at parties".

- 4 **Paul Langier Brut Champagne (Champagne)** **£35.00**

FRANCE 12% [1]

- 6 **La Pintora Sauvignon Blanc (Central Valley)** **£4.15 £5.75 £17.00**

CHILE 12% [2]

This refreshing Sauvignon offers intense passion fruit and herb aromas alongside a wealth of zippy, bright flavours. Crisp and clean on the palate, with a rich weight of fruit and soft structure, this exuberantly fruity and grassy white pairs well with most dishes and great just on its own.

- 7 **Hawks View Chardonnay (South Eastern Australia)** **£4.15 £5.75 £17.00**

AUSTRALIA 13.5% [2]

Soft pineapple fruit dominates this easy-drinking, delicious white. Unoaked, clean, bright and mouthwateringly refreshing, this is superb value for money "Gentle pineapple flavours dominate this easy-drinking white".

- 8 **Cape Spring Chenin Blanc (Western Cape)** **£4.15 £5.75 £17.00**

SOUTH AFRICA 13% [2]

A really exciting Chenin Blanc from South Africa that's easy-drinking, fresh and crisp. This is a dry, unoaked wine marked by delicious, ripe, tropical fruit flavours with attractive aromas of lime zest and guavva. "Brilliant value, versatile and refreshing".

- 9 **Cavatina Pinot Grigio Delle Venezie I.G.T. (delle Venezie)** **£4.60 £6.25 £18.00**

ITALY 12% [2]

A wonderfully crisp and aromatic dry white Pinot Grigio from the north of Italy. The stylish bottle and modern flavour profile, with notes of fresh lemon, lime and a touch of thyme.

- 10 **Les Prades Picpoul de Pinet (Languedoc)** **£25.50**

FRANCE 12.5% [1]

Calvet has a lifted nose of citrus fruit and white blossom. Vibrant on the palate with green apple freshness and a long, balanced finish. "A crisp, fresh white from Southern France" Great with seafood or own its own.

Rosé Wine

- 11 **River Wild White Zinfandel** **£4.15 £5.75 £17.00**

CALIFORNIA 10.5% [4]

This a light-hearted and easy drinking White Zinfandel that doesn't take itself too seriously. Medium bodied there are attractive floral aromas and deliciously fruity raspberry, strawberry and watermelon flavours. A must for all Zinfandel lovers!!!

- 12 **Cavantina Pinot Grigio Blush (IGT delle Venezie)** **£4.60 £6.25 £18.00**

ITALY 12% [2]

A delicious Pinot Grigio rose showing, delicate red fruit flavours. A true rosé made from Pinot Grigio is a rarity, as it can only be made in years when the hot autumn sun turns the grape skins a copper colour. When pressed the grapes give the wine a pale pink tinge, floral aromas and soft, red fruit flavours.

Red Wine

- 13 **La Pintora Merlot (Central Valley)** **£4.15 £5.75 £17.00**

CHILE 12.5% [C]

Lashings of ripe, complex, berry fruit marks out this 100% varietal Merlot. A short time in contact with oak imparts a pleasing vanilla character overlaying the sweet cherry palate. With evident concentration, the flavours linger long on the powerful finish. Great Merlot with a stamp of place about it.

- 14 **Hawks View Shiraz (South Eastern Australia)** **£4.15 £5.75 £17.00**

AUSTRALIA 13.5% [B]

This classic Australian red has a dash of Grenache in the blend, helping to create it's rich, ripe and generous character. Packed with blackberry fruit flavours with a touch of pepper and spice.

- 15 **La Pintora Cabernet Sauvignon (Central Valley)** **£4.15 £5.75 £17.00**

CHILE 12.5% [C]

Straightforward black fruit and some lovely chocolatey cassis dominate this easy-going Chilean wine that is sure to please many a red wine drinker. It's characterful, with a bold liquorice-infused palate backed by tannins and freshness, which give good structure. The sweet, ripe finish will be a versatile match for a wide variety of food as well as own it's own.

- 16 **El Mestengo The Wild One Malbec (San Juan)** **£19.50**

ARGENTINA 14% [C]

Pretty, soft and relaxed, this Malbec has partial and subtle oak ageing, leaving the emphasis on the fruit rather than heavyweight complexity. The silky palate with spice, damson and black cherry flavours is lightly balanced with some chocolate tones on the finish.

- 17 **Campo Dorado Rioja Crianza (Rioja)** **£24.00**

SPAIN 13.5% [C]

This deep cherry red wine is full of black fruit and liquorice notes, with hints of cocoa and toast from 12 months' ageing in American oak barrels. Supple tannins and elegant on the palate.
